



Kitsap 9-11 Memorial Stewardship Program

Upon completion of the Kitsap 9-11 Memorial Project, the memorial was dedicated to the City of Bremerton on September 11, 2013. The Bremerton VFW Post 239 became the official stewards of the memorial. Since this partnership was formed the location has become a popular destination spot to enjoy the beautiful views and to experience this remarkable memorial.

To help with the critical on-going maintenance of the memorial the VFW is asking for volunteer stewards. Community, military groups, families, businesses or individuals are being sought to help assist with tasks such as pulling weeds, trimming grass, raking leaves or keeping cement areas swept and clean. Each steward group will be asked to commit to maintain the memorial for one month a year. Grass mowing is done by the City of Bremerton Parks Department.

Each steward group will receive a Certificate of Appreciation by the VFW Post 239 for their community service.
