On behalf of the Washington State Department of Transportation, I would like to express our support for the City of Bremerton's proposal to widen the sidewalks on the SR 303 Warren Avenue Bridge. The existing sidewalks on the approximately 1,700-foot long bridge are about 3-feet 11-inches wide, and this project would increase that width to 8-feet. Barrier would also be installed between the widened sidewalk and vehicular traffic

Therefore, based on the conceptual information provided to us to date, WSDOT is in support of the City of Bremerton's quest for Puget Sound Regional Council (PSRC) and Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) funds, provided that these improvements meet all applicable WSDOT design and construction requirements, including all applicable American with Disabilities Act (ADA) requirements, for any work that occurs on the SR 303 state highway right-of-way.
