

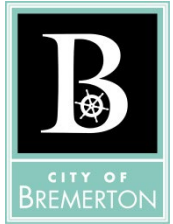

Keep WA Rolling Transportation Package

Bremerton's administration has been working to ensure legislators are informed of the need to improve our local transportation and infrastructure. A new proposal before the state's Legislature this year would provide funding for:

- Warren Ave Bridge safety improvements - \$25 million
- Kitsap Transit All-Electric Foot Ferry for Bremerton-Port Orchard Route - \$6.5 million
- Widening of SR3/Gorst area - \$74.2 million
- Widening & safety improvements SR3/Belfair Area - \$35 million

The total funding proposed is \$140 million for Bremerton and our local region!

Along with the proposal to make ferry fares free for youth, the state ferry system would also get \$350 million to help hire, train and retain employees to meet workforce challenges. Another \$1.3 billion will be spent on building four new hybrid-electric ferries and electrifying two existing vessels in the fleet.
