MINUTES PUBLIC HEARING 2 OF 2 MAY 7, 2024

Present: Attending in person were Chair Deborah McDaniel, Commissioner Kirstie Haertel, and Debbie Klinefelter, Human Resources Analyst I.

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 4:30 PM.

Chair Deborah McDaniel welcomed Tia Hudson, the City's Poet Lauret, to the meeting and she introduced her to all who were present. There was one member of the public who attended via Zoom and did not comment or otherwise participate.

Approval of Minutes from April 18, 2024 Meeting: Motion to approve the Minutes as presented was made by Kirstie, seconded by Deborah and carried unanimously.

Discussion on Council Salaries: Deborah started the discussion by recapping from their previous meeting that the Commission intends to give the Bremerton City Council Members a raise that maintains parity with 90 times the Washington State minimum wage rate. She explained that this keeps the Council Members eligible for the one benefit they have available with their employment with the City and that is their option to participate in the Washington State Retirement System. Deborah also mentioned keeping the Council President stipend unchanged and that it would be added as an agenda item for discussion during their first meeting in 2025.

Open for Public Input: Ms. Hudson was provided with the data the Commission members analyzed. She resides in Council Member Anna Mockler's district and stated how hard the Council members work for their residents. She encouraged increasing the Council's salaries for the reason that because the salaries are not high, only residents in a certain income bracket are willing to hold these offices, and that diversity in income comes into play. The Commission members agreed, and Kirstie explained that at one point the Council Members' salary calculations were not keeping up with minimum wage. In recent years that has been corrected, and in comparing Bremerton's data with other similarly situated jurisdictions, Bremerton's salaries are comparable. Ms. Hudson agreed, said the Commission members were doing a good job and she thanked them.

Conversation ensued and it was determined that incentivizing Council Member engagement with the community would be outside the scope of the Commission's authority.

Motion was made that effective January 1, 2025, Council Members shall receive an increase equal to that applied to the Washington State 2025 minimum wage increase. M/S/C (McDaniel/Haertel).

Motion was made that effective January 1, 2025, the Council President's stipend shall remain \$452.00 per month during their appointed term as President for the remainder of 2024 and until further amended. M/S/C (McDaniel/Hartel).

Motion to adopt the 2025-2026 Council Member Salary Schedule as presented.. M/S/C (McDaniel/Haertel).

Effective Date: 2024 salaries, as approved, will take effect thirty (30) days after being filed with the City Clerk.
