B21-000565, Homicide 2nd degree

On 1-30-21 sixteen-year-old Lola F. Luna stabbed another sixteen-year-old female, also a Bremerton resident, multiple times during an altercation. The crime occurred in front of Luna's residence in the 3300 block of Solie Avenue in Bremerton, WA. The decedent had been driven to the home to fight Luna. The violent assault with a knife resulted in the decedent being driven to the Urgent Care in East Bremerton (the old Harrison Hospital emergency room) for treatment. She was later airlifted to Harborview Medical Center in Seattle where she succumbed to her injuries.

Luna has been charged as an adult in Kitsap County Superior Court, appearing in court on 2/1/21. She was held on \$100,000 bail. The suspect in this case is still in jail as of 9:00AM on 2-2-21.

This investigation is ongoing. Bremerton Police detectives continue to work on this case interviewing witnesses, serving warrants, analyzing physical and video evidence, locating potential new witnesses, and anticipating the need to re-interview others. An autopsy has been scheduled with the King County Medical examiner's office for 2/2/21. Law enforcement is also monitoring social media related to this case.
