Fugitive Captured

On 9/11/14 the Bremerton Police Department's Special Operations Group received information that the girlfriend of Holden Lippard-Taste had stolen a debit card from her mother. A review of the transactions revealed the daughter had rented a room at a west Bremerton hotel.

Detectives from the Special Operations Group responded to that location and found Lippard-Taste's girlfriend, a 19 year old Bremerton woman, in a hotel room and Lippard-Taste hiding under the bed. Both were taken into custody without incident.

Lippard-Taste was the victim of an assault sometime around September 3rd. It is unknown why or where the assault occurred. He received a substantial laceration across the top of his head. Detectives learned Lippard-Taste received medical treatment for his wound at a Seattle hospital under a false name. Medical aid was called to the scene of the arrest to evaluate his existing injury.

Detectives have secured a search warrant for the room and are still investigating.

Holden Lippard-Taste was booked into the Kitsap County jail for five warrants and a new charge of violation of a protection order DV. His bail was set at \$225,000. His warrants were:

- KCSO Felony warrant for Assault 2nd Degree- \$100,000 bail.
- KCSO Felony warrant for Violation of a DV Protection order- \$50,000 bail.
- BMC Misdemeanor warrant for DV Malicious Mischief 3rd Degree-\$25,000 bail.
- BMC Misdemeanor warrant for two counts of Violation of DV No Contact/Protection Order- \$25,000.
- BMC Misdemeanor warrant for DV Assault 4th Degree, DV Malicious Mischief 3rd and DV Harassment- \$25,000 bail.

Lippard-Taste's girlfriend was arrested for the theft of the debit card and rendering criminal assistance. Her bail was set at \$25,000. The Bremerton Police are not naming the girlfriend at this time as she is the protected person in the DV no contact order issued against Lippard-Taste, as well as the victim in the crimes related to the Bremerton Municipal Court Warrants for his arrest.
