Project Status: Concept & Alternative Development (Supported by HDR Engineering, Inc.)

What's Happening?

The City of Bremerton plans to re-channelize the 6th Street corridor (including portions of Kitsap Way east of 11th Street) to improve safety for all road users and provide continuous on-street bike lanes as guided by the City's Comprehensive Plan. Re-channelization includes modifying the existing roadway use primarily through revisions to pavement markings, signage, intersections layouts, traffic signals, and other associated minor roadway improvements supporting the re-channelization.

- Improve vehicle, cyclist, and pedestrian safety & comfort
- Provides new bike lanes and linking SR-3 to downtown
- Improve traffic flow consistency and reduce vehicle travel speeds

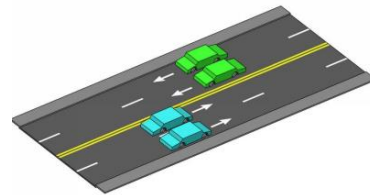

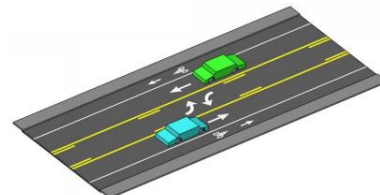
