1. What is the extent of public outreach for this project?

**Public outreach under this contract may include project-specific information meetings hosted in-person or virtually, solicitation of community or targeted stakeholder input through meetings, mailed information, and/or online forms. It is expected that public-facing materials such as flyers, exhibits, letters, etc. would be developed by the selected consultant or the City to support public outreach efforts and may require translation. The selected consultant in collaboration with City staff will develop a public and stakeholder**



**outreach plan which considers previous public outreach conducted by the City and allowing for meaningful information sharing and opportunities for input from the community for this project.**

2. Do we need to show right-of-way and construction services in our statement of qualifications for potential future addendums?

**The published Notice to Consultants states that “The City of Bremerton reserves the right to retain the services of the successful firm(s) for any subsequent project phases (such as Right-of-Way and/or Construction Phase Services) associated with this project.” It is highly recommended that consultant’s structure proposed teams to adequately show qualifications and experience for both Right-of-Way and Construction Phase Services which may be required for the project. It is anticipated, at a minimum, that temporary construction easements will be required for this project. Construction phase services are considered on a case-by-case basis by the City depending on several factors such as City staff workload, project complexity, and construction documentation requirements. Construction phase services may include, but are not limited to, bid and pre-construction phase support, construction inspection, construction management, contractor submittal reviews, construction documentation, and construction close-out.**
