- 5) How would this proposal affect implementing land use regulations (i.e. zoning)? What changes would be necessary to bring the implementing land use regulations into compliance with the Comprehensive Plan?
- 6) How would this proposal affect or create a need for infrastructure improvements, such as water, sewer, transportation etc. in the vicinity?
- 7) How will this amendment benefit the citizens of Bremerton?
- 8) Provide all data, or research, that supports the proposed amendment.
