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Narrative:	<p>As members of the Career Crimes Detective C. HAYES and I were assigned to conduct an investigation for the Bremerton Police Department; regarding a theft by one of their officers during the course of a search warrant. The officer in question is JEFFREY L. INKLEBARGER a current member of the Bremerton Police Department assigned to the Special Operations Group (SOG). This is a five man drug unit, with one Sergeant and four officers / detectives. This incident occurred on 2/26/2019 at [REDACTED] in Bremerton, WA.</p> <p>On 12/13/2019 Sergeant T. White and I met with the Chief of the Bremerton Police Department JIM BURCHETT and Captain TOM WOLFE of the Bremerton Police Department. 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1. Clip -Canary 2019-03-07T05-(17)-11Z *(Theft of money from Purse and Safe /Lock Box)

This clip is from the camera across from the desk. This clip shows JEFFERY INKLEBARGER walking down the stairs into the room. He places papers on the chair and starts going through a bag / purse on the floor. He removes the money from the bag /purse and places it on the chair. He then stands up picks the money up off the chair and folds it up and places it in his right rear pocket. He then takes pictures after he has taken the money and placed it into his back pocket. (He did not photograph the evidence in place and did not submit the money into evidence. His pictures are not a true and accurate representation of the scene).

JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then continues to take photographs of the scene with his phone. He takes photos from the standing position and then takes photos bent over for close up photos of the evidence. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then looks on the ground at the bends down and grabs the red heater and then he grabs the small safe / lock box and rotates it for a better view. He then gets on his knees and takes out his phone. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER appears to unlock his phone and starts taking pictures from his knee of the areas around him. He then quits taken pictures and starts grabbing items out of the small safe/lock box and lying them down in front of him taking pictures of the items. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then reached into the small safe / lock box and takes out a small black bag at the same time he is conversing with another officer off video about taking photographs and doing other stuff. He then opens the black bag and starts looking around. He empties the contents of the bag which is money in his right hand. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER is then seen straitening the money (Per [REDACTED] during her interview she stated the money was folded in \$100.00 dollar bundles and placed in the bag.) JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then looks around at the same time sits up and he places all the money in his right rear pant pocket. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then places something in the black and places the bag in front of himself and takes pictures of the bag. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then engages in conversation with another officer in the adjoining room. Another officer appears briefly in the surveillance video and JEFFERY INKLEBARGER continues taking pictures and bagging evidence.

JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then gets up walks over to by the stairs and places the evidence he bagged on the floor at the bottom of the stairs. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then picks up the purse that is laying on the floor in front of the chair and places it onto the chair. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then pulls out what appears to be a women's wallet from the purse JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then takes money out of the bag /purse and places it into a women's wallet. He then takes the cell phone and places that in an evidence bag. The wallet he places back in the bag. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then starts going through the purse again pulling out items (Pill Bottles) looking at them and then placing it back into the bag / purse. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then takes out his camera and starts taking pictures of the bag /purse. (This is not a true and accurate representation of the evidence as to what it looked like prior to searching.) JEFFERY INKLEBARGER again pulls out the women's wallet he placed into the purse and opens it and starts taking photos of the women's purse. He then places the wallet in the bag / purse and starts looking at items again in the bag. He takes a pill bottle out of the bag / purse and places the pill bottle on the stairs. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then continues searching the area and desk taking photographs and evidence placing it with the previous items by the stairs. The clip ends with JEFFERY INKLEBARGER looking at pill bottles on the chair. The lone pill bottle he placed on the stairs is still there and not with the other evidence on the floor where he had been placing it.

2. Clip -Canary 2019-03-07T05-(18)-20Z * (Theft of money Black Bag)

This clip is from the camera above facing down towards the desk in the room and floor. It shows JEFFERY INKLEBARGER in the room / area. This clip is the same as (Clip #1 -Canary 2019-03-07T05-(17)-11Z *) it just shows the incident from a different angle which is from above. It appears that the item he places in the small black bag is some money.

3. Clip -Canary 2019-03-07T05-(20)-15Z * (Theft Money from Safe not in black bag)

This clip is from the camera above facing down towards the desk in the room and floor. You see a patrol officer in full uniform walking through the area. You see JEFFERY INKLEBARGER walk into the room he first looks at the desk and then he bends over and looks down at the safe on the floor. You then see

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JEFFERY INKLEBARGER look around he then quickly bends down further and grab something out of the safe with his right hand and conceal it in his right hand. He then leaves the room out of view of the camera. You also see an officer shining his flashlight in the room. (The item taken from the safe was a \$100.00 dollar bill per [REDACTED]. She had made two \$100.00 dollar drug transactions that morning prior to the search warrant being served)

4. Clip -Canary 2019-03-07T05-(24)-03Z * (Theft Money from Safe not in black bag)

This clip shows a view of the desk downstairs. This is a straight on view from the camera facing the desk. This clip shows two officers clearing the room during the service of the search warrant. It shows JEFFERY INKLEBARGER in the room after it was cleared by the first two officers. It shows JEFFREY INKLEBARGER coming into the room in view of the camera and bending over with his hands on his knees looking around. Officer JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then leaves the room and goes back up the stairs he had come down. You hear officers saying let's do a secondary because it is such a mess. The camera then shows officer JEFFERY INKLEBARGER coming back into the room from left to right walking out of the view of the camera. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then reappears from the right into the room in view of the camera. He looks at the desk, bends down looking towards the floor, he then peers up looks to his left then right and quickly bends down reaching into the safe with his right hand and grabs an item out of the safe that was on top at the same time looking around. (Per the victim during our interview it was a \$100.00 dollar bill). He has the money in his right hand and starts talking to another officer not seen on camera and starts a conversation about hunting and guns. JEFFERY INKLEBARGER then exits the desk area and walks over to the stairs which are covered by a white curtain of some kind blocking the view of the camera. He is still talking to an officer off camera. You cannot see what he is doing with the money. A short while later another officer pulls back the plastic tarp and peers into the room for a few seconds and he leaves up the stairs. Towards the end of the video you see an officer pull down the curtain that was blocking the view of the stairs. The officer then walks up the stairs and JEFFERY INKLEBARGER comes walking down the stairs taking photographs with his cell phone of the downstairs area and then he heads back up the stairs. The length of this video clip is 4 minutes and 21 seconds.

5. Clip -Canary 2019-03-07T05-(32)-49Z

This clip shows a view of the desk downstairs. This is a straight on view from the camera facing the desk. It shows officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER going through the desk, looking at plastic bags and picking them up and sniffing them. It shows officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER taking photos, picking up evidence, going through the desk and desk drawers. It shows him walking out of sight with a baggie and coming back in view and then he walks upstairs.

6. PNG Image

This shows a picture of officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER downstairs.

7. Clip -Canary 2019-03-07T05-(43)-17Z

This clip is a view from up above facing down towards the floor. This clips shows officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER going through the desk and desk drawers. He is holding his cell phone and a plastic bag in his left hand. He is also taking pictures. He leaves the view of the camera and returns a short time later with his cell phone and plastic bag. He places the phone into his right rear pocket and exits the room. The plastic bag is still in his left hand as he leaves. The length of this video clip is 1 minute and 20 seconds.

8. Clip -Canary 2019-03-07T05-(43)-37Z

This clip shows a view of the desk downstairs. This is a straight on view from the camera facing the desk. This clip shows officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER going through the desk picking up a red container. It then shows him picking up a plastic baggie with unknown substance raising it to his nose and sniffing it. He then opens the baggie looks at it and raises it to his nose again and he sniffs it again. He then places it back on the desk and starts taking photographs with his phone and starts looking through the items again on the

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desk. It then shows him going upstairs. After about a minute JEFFREY INKLEBARGER comes back down stairs goes into the adjoining room out of view of the camera and then he reappears and goes back upstairs.

9. Clip -Canary 2019-03-07T05-(49)-20Z

This clip shows a view of the desk downstairs. This is a straight on view from the camera facing the desk. This clip shows an officer coming downstairs with [REDACTED] who is gathering her jacket and property to go with the officer. The length of this video clip is 2 minutes and 11 seconds.

10. Clip -Canary 2019-03-03T10-(55)-55Z

This clip shows a view of the desk downstairs. This is a straight on view from the camera facing the desk. This is the same clip as Canary 2019-03-07T05-(17)-11Z *(Theft of money from Purse and Safe /Lock Box). The length of this video clip is 10 minutes and 23 seconds.

11. Clip -Canary 2019-03-05T11-(36)-30Z

This clip is a view from up above facing down towards the floor. It shows officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER going through the desk area and then it shows the [REDACTED] with pill bottles in her hand and she places the bottles desk and shows officers evidence. The length of this video clip is 1 minutes and 20 seconds.

JEFFREY INKLEBARGER takes money on three separate occasion when you are watching the surveillance clips.

1. The first time is when he goes downstairs JEFFREY INKLEBARGER quickly grabs something from the bag / purse. (Per the victim it is a hundred dollar bill.)
2. The second time is when he is going through the purse on the chair he takes a hand full of money and places the money in his right rear pant pocket.
3. The third time he takes money is from the black bag that was in the lock box /safe.

I also reviewed the property report done by officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER and his incident report authored by him. He placed all items into property per his report. Only \$25.00 dollars was placed into evidence, per his property report.

Officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER also stated on his report "I certify under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief". Officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER was not truthful in his report and did not place all evidence into property as stated in his report either. Officer JEFFREY INKLEBARGER has perjured himself, tampered with evidence and stole evidence on three separate occasions during the course of the service of the search warrant scene. His report is not a true and accurate representation of his actions during he course of the search warrant. This case will be forwarded to the prosecutors office for review.

On 12/17/2019 we spoke to JENIECE LACROSS, the attorney for [REDACTED] AKA as [REDACTED]. We asked if we could speak to her client, [REDACTED], reference the search warrant at her residence. We specifically asked to speak to her about what was taken, what we were looking at on the video, and how much money was taken. JENIECE LACROSS was concerned about her client's Fifth Amendment Rights. We told her that she was the victim and we would not be advising her of her rights in this case. JENIECE LACROSS told us she would talk to her client and get back to us.

On the morning of 12/19/2019 I received a voice mail message from JENIECE LACROSS to call her reference setting up a meeting time.

On 12/19/19, at approximately 1400 hours, I called JENIECE LACROSS at her office (360) 329-4103 and arranged for a meeting with myself, DETECTIVE WILLIAMS, JENIECE LACROSS, and her client, [REDACTED]. The meeting was scheduled for 1000 hours the following day at JENIECE LACROSS' office located at 904 Dwight Street in Port Orchard.

On 12/20/19, at approximately 1000 hours, DETECTIVE WILLIAMS and I went to the law offices of JENIECE LACROSS & ASSOCIATES for the prearranged meeting with JENIECE LACROSS and [REDACTED]. After brief introductions, clerical information was obtained from [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said her date of birth is [REDACTED]. She resides at [REDACTED] in Bremerton, Washington. Her phone number is [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] identified [REDACTED] as the address where the search warrant was executed.

[REDACTED] was asked what type of camera system was in place during the search warrant service. She identified it as a "Canary" motion-sensor camera, which she said is distorted from night to dawn and jumps when motion is detected. [REDACTED] was then shown several still images printed from her video surveillance footage. The photos were labeled "A-E" to help facilitate identification.

Photo "A" captioned "Picture of basement/downstairs" - [REDACTED] identified a black cash box situated on the floor, a red heater, and a purse containing her cell phone.

Photo "B" captioned "Officer going through purse" - This photo showed OFFICER INKLEBARGER bent over and looking into [REDACTED] purse. [REDACTED] said OFFICER INKLEBARGER took a \$100 bill that had been sitting freely in her purse.

Photo "C" captioned "Picture of safe" - This photo was a close-up/enhanced image of the safe. [REDACTED] said that a black bag was situated inside the safe and had stacks of bills in \$100 increments. In addition to that, the safe contained a black cash bag, a movie DVD, a plastic bag containing

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methamphetamine, an envelope, and an item believed to be another \$100 bill. [REDACTED] had a pill bottle in it that is now missing. OFFICER INKLEBARGER is observed removing an item from the safe and cupping it in his right hand. [REDACTED] believes that it was a \$100 bill but she said, "I can't say for sure."

Photo "D" captioned "Officer kneeling in front of safe"- This photo showed OFFICER INKLEBARGER kneeling in front of the safe. Again, [REDACTED] identified the black cash bag in the safe and it contained \$400 in \$100 bill stacks in various denominations.

Photo "E" captioned "Officer going through black bag taking money" - This photo showed OFFICER INKLEBARGER looking into a bag. [REDACTED] identified the black cash bag and said a \$100 bill was missing.

I asked [REDACTED] how she learned of the missing items. [REDACTED] said after the search warrant service, she met with BILLY (SERGEANT RENFRO) and JORDAN (OFFICER EJDE) in an office at the Bremerton Police Department. [REDACTED] was told that there was only \$25 found in her home. [REDACTED] said she told the officers, "I know for a fact I had at least two \$100 dollar bills." After making that comment, [REDACTED] said OFFICER INKLEBARGER barged into the room, put his cell phone down on the table in front of her, and said, "I have pictures!" then walked out of the room.

[REDACTED] was provided with a return of service receipt but her missing money was not notated on it. She assumed the police deducted their controlled buy money (money that was used to buy narcotics from her prior to the search warrant), which she believed would account for the discrepancy. [REDACTED] said her and her son's cell phones were taken but returned to them.

[REDACTED] went home after she left the meeting with SERGEANT RENFRO and OFFICER EJDE. [REDACTED] said her 16 year old son had viewed the surveillance video from the search warrant and told [REDACTED], "You need to get down here. You need to watch this." [REDACTED] said, "I looked at the first one (video clip) and he (OFFICER INKLEBARGER) takes it (money) out of my purse and sticks it in his right back pocket."

[REDACTED] said she was missing \$600 in total. \$400 had been taken from the aforementioned black bag, \$100 taken from her purse, and \$100 taken from the top of the safe. [REDACTED] said she is sure of the amount she had because she conducted two drug sales that morning that were \$100 each.

[REDACTED] was asked who all had seen the video [REDACTED] said she showed it to her parents, her boyfriend, and to JENIECE LACROSS. [REDACTED] commented that she thought about giving the video to SERGEANT RENFRO but her parents advised against it and said, "Absolutely not." They instructed her to make copies and contact her attorney. [REDACTED] said the entire video is retained on her system as she "bookmarked it."

[REDACTED] said she had not had any contact with OFFICER INKLEBARGER prior to or since the search warrant.

The interview concluded at approximately 1040 hours.

After the interview, DETECTIVE WILLIAMS and I went to the Bremerton Police Department and met with CHIEF JAMES BURCHETT. He escorted us to his office and we briefed him on the meeting with [REDACTED] and JENIECE LACROSS.

We inquired about the team structure to which OFFICER INKLEBARGER was assigned. CHIEF BURCHETT said OFFICER INKLEBARGER was part of the Special Operations Group (SOG), and they investigated Narcotics, Vice, and Homicides. He said they were not part of the task force but rather a five-officer team with one sergeant and four officers.

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In addition to OFFICER INKLEBARGER, the team members who were present and completed reports (reference Bremerton PD case #B19-001135) on the day the search warrant was executed are as follows:

CHIEF BURCHETT was asked how he learned of this incident. CHIEF BURCHETT said he received a phone call from PROSECUTOR IONE GEORGE last Tuesday (12/10/19) about this case. CHIEF BURCHETT told her he would discuss it with her the following day as they have a Detective's Meeting with her every Wednesday.

CHIEF BURCHETT subsequently met with PROSECUTOR IONE GEORGE the following day. PROSECUTOR IONE GEORGE told her that JENIECE LACROSS contacted her and said that she had a client who said SOG raided her house. JENIECE LACROSS inquired about the case and wanted to know the status and what her client was going to be charged with. PROSECUTOR IONE GEORGE told JENIECE LACROSS that she had not received that case. JENIECE LACROSS then told PROSECUTOR IONE GEORGE that if she (PROSECUTOR IONE GEORGE) got the case, then she (JENIECE LACROSS) wanted immunity for her client. PROSECUTOR IONE GEORGE informed JENIECE LACROSS that she would not give her client immunity before seeing what the case was about.

CHIEF BURCHETT said he arranged to have a meeting with JENIECE LACROSS. Later that day, he received a call back from KITSAP COUNTY PROSECUTOR CHAD ENRIGHT that the meeting with JENIECE LACROSS had been scheduled.

CHIEF BURCHETT subsequently met with JENIECE LACROSS and she relayed information that was consistent with what PROSECUTOR IONE GEORGE had told him. JENIECE LACROSS said there was compelling evidence of officer misconduct and presented the video to him on a laptop. JENIECE LACROSS had previously shown the video to PROSECUTOR IONE GEORGE and CHAD ENRIGHT as well.

The following day (Thursday) the video was collected and the incident was reported internally. CHIEF BURCHETT then made an inquiry to the Tacoma Police Department (TPD) to investigate this case. He subsequently met with staff from TPD and briefed them on this situation.

Our meeting with CHIEF BURCHETT concluded at approximately 1200 hours.

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Narrative:	INTERVIEW- KITSAP COUNTY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE
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On 1-10-20, at approximately 1230 hours, DETECTIVE WILLIAMS and I went to the Kitsap County Prosecutor's office located at 614 Division Street in Port Orchard for a prearranged meeting with KITSAP COUNTY PROSECUTING ATTORNEY IONE GEORGE and CAPTAIN TOM WOLFE of the Bremerton Police Department. Upon arrival we contacted PROSECUTOR GEORGE and CAPTAIN WOLFE in PROSECUTOR GEORGE's office. Also present was CAPTAIN RANDY PLUMB with the Bremerton Police Department.

A discussion of this incident, which involved a brief synopsis of the allegations, ensued. The allegations being that OFFICER INKLEBARGER stole money and possibly pills during the course of a narcotics search warrant. We discussed the next course of action, which included setting up interviews with OFFICER JORDAN EJDE and SERGEANT BILLY RENFRO who were both present during the search warrant at [REDACTED] residence. SERGEANT BILLY RENFRO was OFFICER INKLEBARGER's supervisor at the scene. We also discussed setting up an interview with OFFICER INKLEBARGER in the coming week.

I asked CAPTAIN WOLFE when OFFICER INKLEBARGER was placed on administrative leave and the reason he was told for his hiatus. CAPTAIN WOLFE said OFFICER INKLEBARGER was placed on administrative leave on Friday, December 13th. At that time, OFFICER INKLEBARGER was made to relinquish his gun and was told that there was a serious allegation that involved gross misconduct. CAPTAIN WOLFE told him an outside agency was handling the investigation to make sure it was fair and impartial. CAPTAIN WOLFE provided us with OFFICER INKLEBARGER's cell phone number and home number for contact.

It was determined that after the investigation was completed, this case would be forwarded to PROSECUTOR GEORGE for review and possible charging considerations for Theft and Perjury. It appears that OFFICER INKLEBARGER stole money on at least three separate occasions. OFFICER INKLEBARGER's report indicates he found \$25 during the search warrant; However, [REDACTED] indicated there was \$600 missing. That is believed to be the money that OFFICER INKLEBARGER stole and his actions were captured on video surveillance footage. The perjury charge references OFFICER INKLEBARGER's police report where he documented that "In the open lock box at the foot of the dresser, I observed twenty-five dollars cash, sandwich baggie containing a black tar substance which using a NIK test kit showed a positive presumptive presence of heroin, 7.9 grams (item J19). I also located a sandwich baggie containing NIK positive methamphetamine, 13.9 grams (item J116). The lock box contained twenty five dollars in cash (item J11) and various unused baggies and rubber bands."

I checked OFFICER INKLEBARGER's property report associated with this case and noted that twenty five dollars in cash (item J11) is the only money documented.

OFFICER INKLEBARGER reported that he photographed the evidence and then placed all of the items into evidence. There is a declaration at the bottom of OFFICER INKLEBARGER's report that states the following: "I certify or declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief." If OFFICER INKLEBARGER stole money during the warrant then his report is not an accurate, true, or complete record.

PROSECUTOR GEORGE, CAPTAIN WOLFE and CAPTAIN PLUMB said they would prefer the issuance of a summons as opposed to a custodial arrest. The interview concluded at approximately 1330 hours.

After the interview, CAPTAIN WOLFE asked if we would be amenable to conducting interviews with SERGEANT RENFRO and OFFICER EJDE as they were most likely available. We agreed and met CAPTAIN WOLFE and CAPTAIN PLUMB at the Bremerton Police Department.

INTERVIEW- SERGEANT BILLY RENFRO

Upon arrival at the Bremerton Police Department, we contacted CAPTAIN WOLFE who informed us that OFFICER EJDE was actually not available but SERGEANT RENFRO was present at the station. DETECTIVE WILLIAMS and I were escorted to conference room upstairs. SERGEANT RENFRO was brought to our location and introductions were made. We provided SERGEANT RENFRO with our business

cards then gave him a brief synopsis of the investigation. SERGEANT RENFRO was allowed to review his supplemental report from the search warrant before the interview commenced.

After SERGEANT RENFRO finished reading his report, he said, "Okay, I remember this one. We did buys." SERGEANT RENFRO said that on the day the search warrant was executed, they conducted a traffic stop on a girl believed to be the suspect's daughter. OFFICER MATTHEW STROMBACH stayed with the girl while SERGEANT RENFRO went to assist on the search warrant.

SERGEANT RENFRO said CAPTAIN WOLFE told him there was an allegation that "JEFF" (OFFICER INKLEBARGER) stole money. SERGEANT RENFRO said, "I've known Jeff for 20 years. I'm mad." He explained that he went from being hurt and disappointed at OFFICER INKLEBARGER to being mad. He said, "Were taking another hit as cops."

We asked SERGEANT RENFRO if he recalled conducting an interview with the main suspect, [REDACTED] AKA [REDACTED], and if he recalled whether the interview was recorded. SERGEANT RENFRO said he could not recall if the interview was recorded. He explained that the interviews for the SOG (Special Operations Group) are usually erased after they are transcribed. He said that if [REDACTED] was interviewed, it would have taken place in an interview room around the corner and would most likely have been recorded. SERGEANT RENFRO said their intent was to sign [REDACTED] up as a confidential informant. He explained that [REDACTED] was supposed to abide by a SOG Agreement, which is a verbal agreement as opposed to a contractual agreement with their prosecutor's office. As part of that agreement, [REDACTED] was supposed to conduct three controlled narcotics buys and identify three individuals who were distributing controlled substances. He said [REDACTED] handler was JORDAN EJDE and he may have been assisted by MATTHEW STROMBACH who was new to the unit.

SERGEANT RENFRO said [REDACTED] reneged on the agreement so there were plans in place to arrest her. Those plans did not come to fruition either because they could not find [REDACTED] or they were busy with other investigations. SERGEANT RENFRO said at one point, they observed [REDACTED] son driving her vehicle and they had him under surveillance at a school. It was their belief that he was in the process of dealing narcotics but [REDACTED] son disappeared before they were able to contact him. SERGEANT RENFRO said there has been nothing further done with her case as far as he knows.

We asked SERGEANT RENFRO if he recalled OFFICER INKLEBARGER barging into the room, putting his phone down on the table, and saying "I have pictures" in response to [REDACTED] statement that more than \$25 should have been found at her house. SERGEANT RENFRO said he did not recall OFFICER INKLEBARGER coming into the room. SERGEANT RENFRO said he rotated out of SOG in July and he is back in Patrol working dayshift. He apologized for not being able to remember if the interview was recorded or if OFFICER INKLEBARGER came into the room but he said JORDAN EJDE is young, he has a memory like a steel trap, and he would be able to recall it. We thanked SERGEANT RENFRO for his time and the interview concluded at approximately 1542 hours. Afterwards, we met with CAPTAIN WOLFE and briefed him on the interview.

On our way back to Tacoma, we received a phone call from CAPTAIN WOLFE. He said JORDAN EJDE would be available for an interview on Tuesday morning (1/14/20). We told CAPTAIN WOLFE that we could do the interview with OFFICER EJDE on that date at the Bremerton Police Department and potentially do an interview with OFFICER INKLEBARGER on that same day. CAPTAIN WOLFE said that if OFFICER INKLEBARGER mentioned a seizure hearing scheduled for next week, we could inform him that it was cancelled. CAPTAIN WOLFE also said it would be okay to mention [REDACTED] name at the time we scheduled the appointment.

When we returned to the CID Office, we met with ASSISTANT CHIEF GUSTASON, LT. LANE, and SERGEANT WHITE in ASSISTANT CHIEF GUSTASON's office. We briefed them on the preceding events and told them that we planned to contact OFFICER INKLEBARGER to arrange an interview with him.

On 1/10/20 at approximately 1617 hours, DETECTIVE WILLIAMS and I called OFFICER INKLEBARGER from my department issued cell phone. After he answered, I told OFFICER INKLEBARGER my name and my agency. I informed him that he was on speakerphone and that my partner, DETECTIVE

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WILLIAMS, was present, DETECTIVE WILLIAMS said hello to OFFICER INKLEBARGER. I confirmed that OFFICER INKLEBARGER was on administrative leave and asked him if he knew the reason why. OFFICER INKLEBARGER said there was an accusation of gross misconduct and he was placed on administrative leave on December 13th. We asked OFFICER INKLEBARGER if he would be willing to meet with us for an interview. He said he was told to contact his Guild Attorney, LISA STYLES (sp) if he was contacted regarding this case. We told OFFICER INKLEBARGER that he could let his attorney know that there was an allegation of theft involving [REDACTED] AKA [REDACTED]. We were investigating the case to make sure that everything was fair and impartial. OFFICER INKLEBARGER said that was relayed to him and he understood, especially with the passage of Washington Initiative 940. He said, "They explained that to me. What could I have possibly done?" OFFICER INKLEBARGER appeared to be making that comment as more of a statement rather than a question. He was told that he would not be physically arrested. OFFICER INKLEBARGER said, "I appreciate you...me and my family have been stressed out. Let's get down to figuring out what's being done." OFFICER INKLEBARGER continued to say, "I appreciate you guys calling. It makes me feel better." We provided OFFICER INKLEBARGER with our cell phone number and desk numbers for contact.

OFFICER INKLEBARGER said, [REDACTED] name sounds familiar. I'll leave it at that." We asked OFFICER INKLEBARGER if he would be able to come in for an interview this coming week. He said, "I'll have her (his attorney) give you a call. I will give her a call now."

At approximately 1630 hours, ATTORNEY LISA ELLIOTT called my cell phone and said she was representing OFFICER INKLEBARGER in this matter. ATTORNEY ELLIOTT was asked if she had any questions. She asked if it was regarding a theft on a search warrant. After she received confirmation, a meeting with OFFICER INKLEBARGER was scheduled for Friday, January 17th at 1000 hours at the Bremerton Police Department.

We initially met with CAPTAIN WOLFE. He escorted us to an upstairs conference room and brought OFFICER EJDE there a few minutes later. After CAPTAIN WOLFE left the conference room, we introduced ourselves and obtained some background information from him. OFFICER EJDE said he currently works in the Narcotics Division. He's been with the Bremerton Police Department for approximately six years and worked as a police officer for Skamania for a couple of years before that.</p> <p>We told OFFICER EJDE that we were following up on an allegation of misconduct. He was given an opportunity to review his supplemental report prior to the start of the interview. After reviewing his report, we asked OFFICER EJDE if he recalled meeting with ██████████ AKA ██████████ at Bremerton PD after the search warrant. OFFICER EJDE said, "I think we met her down here. She drove a Ford." Later in the interview, he did recall meeting with ██████████. OFFICER EJDE said ██████████ was under an agreement with SOG to do three buys from three different dealers. OFFICER EJDE did not recall OFFICER INKLEBARGER coming into the interview room during the interview but he thought OFFICER INKLEBARGER brought ██████████ and her son's cell phones upstairs to process them. OFFICER EJDE was under the impression that ██████████ wiped (deleted information) on her phone because there was nothing on it.</p> <p>We informed OFFICER EJDE that ██████████ house was wired with 4k cameras. He said, "I thought there was video or computers at the house." OFFICER EJDE was told that while OFFICER INKLEBARGER was searching and talking, he was stuffing his pocket full of money. OFFICER EJDE said, "What!" then shook his head from side to side. We asked OFFICER EJDE if he recalled OFFICER INKLEBARGER coming into the room and putting his phone down on the table after ██████████ was told that only twenty five dollars in cash was found at her residence during his and SERGEANT RENFRO's interview with ██████████. OFFICER EJDE said, "I don't remember that scenario. I don't recall that. I was expecting there to be more money." OFFICER EJDE asked, "Just twenty five dollars?" After we confirmed that that was all that was reported in OFFICER INKLEBARGER's report and on the property sheet, OFFICER EJDE, said, "For some reason, I thought we got more than that." OFFICER EJDE remembered there being a bunch of pills in a closet. He said they did two or three buys from ██████████ that consisted of a ball of heroin at \$200 a ball. OFFICER EJDE said he believed she sold the same amount to other people so there should have been more money. OFFICER EJDE said, "I thought we missed something or the money was stashed."</p> <p>OFFICER EJDE was shown a series of photos labeled "A-E" and given an explanation of the items depicted in each one. These were the same photos shown to ██████████ in the presence of her attorney. After</p>

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viewing the photos, OFFICER EJDE said, "It's frustrating." "He totally...I know it's not a venting session...hurt a year's worth of work. He's screwed up."

OFFICER EJDE said [REDACTED] was not charged because her case was contingent on another SOG investigation. OFFICER EJDE said [REDACTED] attorney, JENIECE LACROSS, called him and told him that [REDACTED] did not want to work for them.

OFFICER EJDE was asked when OFFICER INKLEBARGER was assigned to SOG. He said "JEFF" started working in the unit in January of 2019 and he has been a part of everything for the past year. OFFICER EJDE was relieved that OFFICER INKLEBARGER came to the unit after "Red Rocket," a large scale, multi-agency narcotics investigation led by OFFICER EJDE concluded.

OFFICER EJDE recalled another case that he identified as "TREVOR's case." He said it was a narcotics search warrant that occurred in Tacoma in the area of 56th & Mullen. During the search, OFFICER EJDE said that one of his co-workers, identified only as DERRICK, found "dope" in a wall. OFFICER EJDE found \$1600 cash in a coat pocket. "JEFF" was searching another room and he initially said he did not find anything. TREVOR was disappointed so another officer searched the room "JEFF" had searched and found \$1200-1600 dollars in cash. It was then that "JEFF" declared the money and a firearm. OFFICER EJDE thought it was strange that "JEFF" did not find the items.

OFFICER EJDE said LISA ELLIOTT called him on Friday 1/10/20 and wanted to interview him. OFFICER EJDE asked her if she could even speak with him about this investigation. According to OFFICER EJDE, ELLIOTT said, "Yes, I'm your attorney." OFFICER EJDE told ELLIOTT that there was a claim that "JEFF" had taken something during a search warrant." OFFICER EJDE said ELLIOTT also wanted to know how reliable [REDACTED] was and if she was a drug user and drug dealer. OFFICER EJDE said [REDACTED] was a drug user and drug dealer and she was not trying to say otherwise. OFFICER EJDE said ELLIOTT also questioned him about where everybody was during the search warrant and what was found.

OFFICER EJDE said, "I'm mad. I'm disappointed. This is not good."

We asked OFFICER EJDE if he knew whether OFFICER INKLEBERGER had a drug problem and if he was known to abuse sick leave. OFFICER EJDE said he was not aware of OFFICER INKLEBERGER having a drug problem and he said, "I don't know if he abuse sick leave. He had a reputation of being gone often." OFFICER EJDE said the reasons seemed to be legitimate though. He said OFFICER INKLEBARGER broke his back and tore his bicep putting on a tire." OFFICER EJDE described OFFICER INKLEBARGER as "Ricochet Rabbit." He explained that OFFICER INKLEBARGER was always on the go and was a high energy person.

We asked OFFICER EJDE if he had any questions. He did not. I asked OFFICER EJDE if he could show us the room where the interview with [REDACTED] took place. OFFICER EJDE took us to Interview Room #3 located around the corner from the conference room. OFFICER EJDE said the interview was not recorded.

The interview concluded at approximately 1040 hours. We provided OFFICER EJDE with our business cards and thanked him for his time.

CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE said he wrote the neighbor at [REDACTED] a parking ticket for blocking as they were not giving the legal five feet of clearance.</p>

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CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE was asked how he knew OFFICER INKLEBARGER. CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE said he worked with OFFICER INKLEBARGER since he (OFFICER INKLEBARGER) began employment with the Bremerton Police Department in the early 2000's. CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE was assigned to detectives from 2005 until 2012 and would see OFFICER INKLEBARGER on occasion. CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE said they both worked in patrol around the same time on a 10/40 schedule but CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE was on days and he was on graveyard shift. He said OFFICER INKLEBARGER was also assigned to WestNET but the supervisor dismissed him because of something related to hotel billing where he stayed a full week during training.

We asked CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE if OFFICER INKLEBARGER was frequently gone on sick leave. CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE said, "He was calling in sick quite a bit and that irritated us. He called in whenever he had enough leave to burn. I understand he had a bad back." CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE said at one point he was the "low man on the totem pole" and was often held over when OFFICER INKLEBARGER called in sick.

CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE described OFFICER INKLEBARGER as friendly. He said, "He seemed to get out there and work hard. I can't honestly tell you the last time I worked on shift with him." CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE said outside of work, OFFICER INKLEBARGER coached an opposing kid's baseball team.

CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE was not aware of OFFICER INKLEBARGER having ever stole anything. He was not aware of OFFICER INKLEBARGER having a drug problem. He commented that there was speculation because he was taking too much time off but nothing concrete. He said, "It was more tongue-in-cheek."

The interview with CORPORAL VERTEFEUILLE concluded at approximately 1138 hours.

GREENHILL said during the execution of the search warrant he searched the living room of the residence and went into the back bedroom with DEREK EJDE when he found a rifle and pills. He said he did not search downstairs and that OFFICER JEFFREY INKLEBARGER collected the property from him at the end.

OFFICER BRANDON K. GREENHILL said that OFFICER JEFFREY INKLEBARGER searched downstairs. He said he does not remember going downstairs.

We then asked OFFICER BRANDON K. GREENHILL to explain their process for processing evidence during a search warrant. OFFICER BRANDON K. GREENHILL said they clear the residence. Do a second sweep of the residence. Once that is done they do a walk through and take overall photos and then the case agent interviews the suspects. After overall photos they start searching for evidence and when they find evidence they photograph it in place and then move it, taking additional pictures if required. They move the evidence to one central location to gather later. OFFICER BRANDON K. GREENHILL said, "There is no point in taking pictures if you move it then photograph it". OFFICER BRANDON K. GREENHILL said the case agent was DETECTIVE JORDAN EJDE. He said he mentioned that there should be more money. He said they searched like crazy for the money. They searched wall outlets because they had found newly packaged outlets and thought the suspects may have hidden money / drugs in the receptacle outlets. They thought the suspect was trying to hide money.

OFFICER BRANDON K. GREENHILL said he did not work with OFFICER INKLEBARGER as a detective. He only assisted on warrants as the Directed Enforcement Team (DET) has done on previous occasions.

We asked OFFICER BRANDON K. GREENHILL what he knew about OFFICER INKLEBARGER. He said, "I didn't expect this to be honest. He said he gets frustrated at times and is quick to do things. OFFICER BRANDON K. GREENHILL said after he saw what OFFICER INKLEBARGER had done he was disgusted and has not been sleeping well. HE said this is going to affect all of us some way. He did say that OFFICER INKLEBARGER complained about his back injury and kidney stones. He thought OFFICER INKLEBARGER might have broken his back at some time but was not sure. He also mentioned OFFICER INKLEBARGER had kidney stones and used a lot of sick leave. He did not know if that was related or not. He said he isn't a bad guy, he was never disrespectful, and in fact he was friendly. He was not aware of any drug or pill problems with OFFICER INKLEBARER. He also said after watching the video that it appears OFFICER INKLEBARGER had done this before. We then ended the interview at 1109 hours.

On 1/19/20, at approximately 1000 hours, BREMERTON POLICE OFFICER DERRICK EJDE met me and DETECTIVE WILLIAMS at Tacoma Police Headquarters for a prearranged interview. The interview was conducted in the CID Conference room. After a brief introduction, we obtained clerical information from OFFICER EJDE. He was then given an opportunity to review his supplemental report from the search warrant that occurred on 2/26/19 at [REDACTED].

After reviewing his report, OFFICER EJDE said, "I saw the video. The chief showed us." OFFICER EJDE was referring to clips of video surveillance footage that captured OFFICER INKLEBARGER's actions during the search warrant at the aforementioned location.

We asked OFFICER EJDE if he was familiar with [REDACTED] AKA [REDACTED]. He said, "I remember [REDACTED]. I remember the house. I don't recall most of it. I remember the house and the warrant."

OFFICER EJDE was asked if he had contact with OFFICER INKLEBARGER during the warrant. He said he had contact with him when they cleared the house. OFFICER EJDE said there were hunting clothes in the house so he made an inquiry to OFFICER INKLEBARGER about guns. He said his partner, BRANDON GREENHILL, asked OFFICER INKLEBARGER about taking photos of property that was found.

OFFICER EJDE searched the master bedroom located in the northwest portion of the house. He believed the bedroom belonged to [REDACTED] and her boyfriend, [REDACTED].

OFFICER EJDE recalled another search warrant where OFFICER INKLEBARGER assisted. SOG served the search warrant in Tacoma in the area of South 56th & Mullen and TREVOR DONNELLY was the case agent. OFFICER EJDE said money and narcotics were secreted all over the apartment. They found large sums of money secreted in pockets of clothes hanging in the closets. OFFICER INKLEBARGER searched the spare bedroom but said that he didn't find anything. Someone mentioned double-checking the closet but OFFICER INKLEBARGER said, "I checked everything in there. Don't worry about it." OFFICER BRANDON GREENHILL and OFFICER JORDAN EJDE went to the spare room and searched the vanity. At that point, OFFICER INKLEBARGER said he found \$1500 in the closet. OFFICER EJDE thought it was odd that OFFICER INKLEBARGER didn't find the money earlier. OFFICER EJDE also wondered if there should have been additional heroin found. OFFICER EJDE located heroin and methamphetamine tucked into drywall behind a mirror near the entrance to the apartment. There was another mirror with a similar void in the master bathroom where OFFICER INKLEBARGER was searching but OFFICER INKLEBARGER said nothing was in it. According to OFFICER EJDE, when the drug dealer was interviewed after the warrant, there was a \$600 discrepancy in what they found and what the dealer said was in the apartment.

OFFICER EJDE said he was mad and upset about this situation so he spoke with SERGEANT RENFRO who is like a mentor to him. OFFICER EJDE said, "Why give people another excuse not to like us." He said there were plenty of overtime opportunities that OFFICER INKLEBARGER could have taken advantage of.

OFFICER EJDE described OFFICER INKLEBARGER as being chaotic sometimes. He gave an example. They were assisting the GIU (General Investigative Unit) with a search warrant. A building was secured and OFFICER EJDE stayed to search with OFFICER INKLEBARGER. OFFICER INKLEBARGER searched a spare room. When OFFICER EJDE went to check on OFFICER INKLEBARGER, he had narcotics and paraphernalia laid out on the floor in front of him. OFFICER EJDE said OFFICER INKLEBARGER said, "This is so and so's dope. Here it is." OFFICER EJDE said, "He left it and didn't even collect it." He said OFFICER INKLEBARGER is proactive. He is always looking for drug dealers and guys with warrants. OFFICER EJDE said, "He's not the best report writer. He's not as detailed."

OFFICER EJDE said that he and OFFICER INKLEBARGER started working with SOG in February of last year. He is aware that OFFICER INKLEBARGER was with WestNET before that but there was a billing conflict and he was sent back.

OFFICER EJDE is not aware of OFFICER INKLEBARGER having any drug addiction issues. He was aware that OFFICER INKLEBARGER injured his back in a collision in patrol. He said OFFICER INKLEBARGER takes a lot of sick leave and vacations.

We thanked OFFICER EJDE for his time and the interview concluded at approximately 1045 hours.

He remained outside where he watched [REDACTED]' daughter, [REDACTED]. After that he went inside and heard JORDAN EJDE and SERGEANT RENFRO speaking with [REDACTED] about working as an informant. CORPORAL STROMBACH went into [REDACTED] and her boyfriend's bedroom and saw an AK47 rifle in the closet. He said he did not participate in the search and did not log evidence. 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husband telling her to cooperate. [REDACTED] then provided information about her narcotics associations.

CORPORAL STROMBACH did not remember OFFICER INKLEBARGER coming into the room, he did not remember if OFFICER INKLEBARGER was recorded during the interview, and he does not remember in which interview room the interview took place although from the directions given, it appears to be interview room #3. CORPORAL STROMBACH said they usually don't interview potential informants at the police department.

I read CORPORAL STROMBACH's supplemental report to him to refresh his memory. CORPORAL STROMBACH said there may be additional supplemental reports authored by him that detailed the controlled buys preceding the search warrant. We explained how OFFICER INKLEBARGER's actions were discovered. CORPORAL STROMBACH said he saw the video and his chief explained what happened. He said the chief briefed SOG and showed them three clips of OFFICER INKLEBARGER in the basement of the house. CORPORAL STROMBACH said, "Just sick."

We asked CORPORAL STROMBACH how well he knew OFFICER INKLEBARGER. CORPORAL STROMBACH said he worked in patrol with him for a number of years and didn't really associate with him outside of work. CORPORAL STROMBACH said, "I championed for him to come to SOG. I thought he would do well. He's a go-getter and he's proactive."

CORPORAL STROMBACH said he knew OFFICER INKLEBARGER had been in trouble before for using excessive force. He said OFFICER INKLEBARGER also had problems turning in reports in a timely manner. CORPORAL STROMBACH said, "He's a busy guy and when it comes time to do paperwork, he's (OFFICER INKLEBARGER) reluctant." CORPORAL STROMBACH said OFFICER INKLEBARGER's nickname is "hummingbird" because he's everywhere all the time and when he does write his reports, he's fast.

CORPORAL STROMBACH said OFFICER INKLEBARGER has "bitched" about his family before, mainly his adult child and he believes that he has a tumultuous family life. CORPORAL STROMBACH was not aware of OFFICER INKLEBARGER having any substance abuse issues. Asked about using excessive sick leave, CORPORAL STROMBACH said, "Yeah, he'll use a lot of sick leave even though he did not bank a lot of sick leave." He said OFFICER INKLEBARGER was off for eight weeks after he snapped a ligament in his arm while changing a tire on his truck. CORPORAL STROMBACH thought OFFICER INKLEBARGER had asked for sick leave donations. CORPORAL STROMBACH said he has not been OFFICER INKLEBARGER's supervisor for very long.

CORPORAL STROMBACH started at the Bremerton Police Department with OFFICER INKLEBARGER in 2003, and OFFICER INKLEBARGER had been with King County a short time before that.

CORPORAL STROMBACH did not have any questions. He said, "This has been the biggest gut punch I think I've ever had. We're a close group. This is the last thing I expected. There was video. It's devastating. A really bad thing. There's no denying it."

The interview with CORPORAL STROMBACH concluded at approximately 1320 hours.
