**THIS ORDER SUPPLEMENTS 2022-006 EMERGENCY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER DATED OCTOBER 16, 2022, AND ALL PREVIOUS ORDERS ISSUED BY THIS COURT.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

1. Bremerton Municipal Court is encouraging zoom appearances unless otherwise directed by the Judge or Commissioner. The public will continue to view court sessions via zoom as an observer or in courtroom 2 in person. Any spectators or defendants appearing at the courthouse will also be allowed to use the Zoom room located in the lobby as an option.
2. Anyone entering the court is required to wear a mask in the courtroom.
3. **For any case continued under the terms of this order the entire period of the continuance constitutes and excluded period when calculating time for trial.** CrRLJ 3.3. These unavoidable circumstances are beyond the control of the court and/or the parties.
4. The courthouse building will be open (M-F) from 8:00-430pm, with the exception of the lunch hour, this will accommodate probation services and the public defenders' hours of operation. The clerk's office will remain on limited hours from 9am-12 and 1pm-3pm until November 1, 2022.
5. The Courthouse will be closed daily during the lunch hour from 12:00 pm – 1:00 pm.

**THIS ORDER WENT INTO EFFECT ON OCTOBER 17TH, 2022 AND WILL BE IN EFFECT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. IT IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE. It shall be posted on the city's website.**
